Rules: Naviga NS and NSS Rules 2016

Categories: F2A, F2B, F2C, F4A, F4B, F4C, F-DS, F6, F7, NSS-A, NSS-B, NSS-C, NSS-D, U-Boot Juniors and Seniors

Junior: Every competitor under the age of 19.

Number of competitors: In addition of the defending Champion, every nation can nominate 5 competitors in every category.

Prize: In every category a “World Champion” will be proclaimed, and in the honour of them their national anthem will be played. The first three place will be announced, and they will receive a medal and a diploma. Every other competitor will receive a diploma.

Fees: Senior: 30.00 EUR – per category  
+ 10.00 EUR – per Person, as a fee for using the Lake  
Junior: 15.00 EUR – per category

Banquet: 25.00 EUR - per Person

Protest fee: As the rules said: 20.00 EUR – per Protest

Deadline of application: 31. 03. 2019 – via Letter or E-Mail

Application:

1. The official application can be done only by the National Association.
2. Every competitor must have a registration form.
3. The team leader must have a full list of the competitors.
4. Every application must have a stamp on it from the National Association.
5. In other forms or variants applications are refused.

Terms of payment: In the name of all competitors, Team leaders must pay the complete Application fee. Without completing the payments none of the competitors, nor teams can participate.  
Deadline of Bank-transfer for Application fees: 31. March 2019.

Required documents: Passport, Visa and another Identification document. Valid insurance for the full-period of staying in Hungary.

Frequencies: 27 MHz, 40 MHz, 2.4 GHz

Channels:

F2, F-DS	27 MHz: channels 9, 10, 12, 13, 19, 24 40 MHz: channels 52, 55, 59, 85, 89 2,4 GHZ
F4	27 MHz: channels 7, 15, 17, 18, 22, 30 40 MHz: channels 50, 57, 81, 82, 91 2,4 GHZ
F6, F7, NSS	27 MHz: all channels 40 MHz: all channels 2,4 GHZ

***The above-mentioned Hungarian frequency rules must be kept!***

National flags and anthem: Every national team must give 3 national flags (100x150 cm) and a CD/DVD of the National Anthem to the organizers. These will be returned to the team leader after the closing ceremony.

Registration on site:

1. The registration must be made with the team leader.
2. The competitor completes the registration with the model-registration-paper of his/her model, then a frequency control will be taken.

Changing any of the following data of the applications:

- Competitor
- Category
- Model
- Frequency

will be fined with 10.00 EUR every time as an administration fee.

**Attention!**

In the F6 and F7 category pyrotechnics could be used ONLY when the competitor gives the following details of the device until 31. March 2019.

- Name of the pyrotechnic device (E)
- Calibre of the device (E)
- Pyrotechnic number of the device (E)
  
- UN-number of the device (E)
- Number of devices

The competitor must declare a statement, that the he/she will use these pyrotechnic devices in a proper and safe way, as called intended use. The statement could be downloaded from the official webpage.

**Using of not registered and not proclaimed, or not allowed pyrotechnic devices entails immediate disqualification.**
